As I am sure all of you are aware the DWP produced a bundle of "goodies" in the form of consultation and feedback papers in mid-July. The subjects covered included value for money, auto-enrolment, BD scheme consolidation, the role of trustees, small "pots", infrastructure investment and understanding pension choices.
